December and one in May. Performances will also be held for community and school audiences.

The ensemble will be led by music director, Nancy Beitler, who recently retired from public school teaching after 32 years of service. Her last position was at Southern Lehigh Middle School, Center Valley, PA where she was responsible for the 7th through 8th grade band, orchestra and general music programs. Presently Dr. Beitler supervises music education student teachers for Moravian College. She continues to mentor young music educators and share her teaching strategies at professional development workshops and seminars. Dr. Beitler has been the coach for

the Young People's Philharmonic Woodwind Quintet since 2015.

Auditions for a position in the Wind Symphony will take place between 3:00 and 8:00 pm on May 8th & 10th to determine the skill level of the applying participants. For the first year, there will be an open enrollment policy, provided all the following requirements are met: 1.) players complete an entrance audition, 2.) have two years of continuous instruction on their instrument and 3.) participate full-time in their school instrumental music programs.
